Like most of the nation, we face a potential crisis because of an aging infrastructure. The American Society of Civil Engineers estimates that \$1.6 trillion is needed over a five-year period to bring the nation's infrastructure to a good condition.

**Consider these facts:**

- 45 percent of our water mains are 25-50 years old.
- 23 percent of the mains are over 50 years old.
- By 2025, it is estimated that approximately 50 percent of our water mains will reach or exceed its useful life. Wastewater mains still have a substantial life span, but many are in need of rehabilitation.
- In FY09, WSSC replaced 35 miles of new water pipe
- In the next ten years an estimated \$3 billion will be needed to pay for water and sewer pipe replacement
