WASHINGTON SUBURBAN SANITARY COMMISSION

Subject: A RESOLUTION adopting Chapter 11.175 of the WSSC Code of Regulations 2024 (“Code”) titled “Replacement of Lead Service Lines”,

WHEREAS, the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission (“Commission”) is authorized and empowered to adopt regulations to protect the public health pursuant to § 17-403 of the Public Utilities Article (“PUA”), Annotated Code of Maryland; and

WHEREAS, WSSC Water has created a Lead Reduction Program (“Program”) designed to protect the public health and to comply with U.S. Environmental Protection Agency’s (“EPA”) proposed revisions to the Lead and Copper Regulations, which is expected to be finalized by EPA on October 16, 2024; and


WHEREAS, the Commission desires to adopt a regulation that establishes the Commission’s policy as it relates to the Commission’s intention to replace lead service lines in the sanitary district and to guide future decisions relating to the funding of the Program; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, this 16th day of October 16, 2024, that the Commission hereby adopts Chapter 11.175 of Title 11, Infrastructure Management, Subtitle V. Water and Sewer Service Authorization, of the WSSC Code of Regulations; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Chapter 11.175 shall be effective on December 1, 2024; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that notice of this resolution and the actions taken hereunder shall be published in at least one newspaper published in each county of the Washington Suburban Sanitary District for thirty days prior to the effective date.
