

A Note from WSSC Water's Intergovernmental Relations Office

Lawmakers are feverishly deliberating over the 2,272 bills introduced thus far during the 2023 Maryland General Assembly Legislative Session. Committee Reporting Courtesy Date is March 14th, and Standing Committees are encouraged to report their chamber's bills to their respective floor by this date if they wish for them to be passed by Crossover on March 20th. Any bills passed in their originating chamber after this date will be referred to the opposite chamber's Rules Committee prior to their introduction.

On Friday, March 10th, the Maryland Board of Revenue Estimates voted to <u>lower FY23 state revenue projections by \$77.4 million</u>. The Board, which consists of Comptroller Brooke Lierman, Treasurer Dereck Davis, and Budget Secretary Helene Grady, also lowered revenue projections for FY24 by \$400.3 million. Maryland is currently underperforming in comparison to other states, specifically in consumer spending and employment.

WSSC Water's **Intergovernmental Relations Office (IRO)** is on the front-line advocating for legislation that impacts our work. **IRO** covers a variety of subject matters and focuses on legislation that helps WSSC Water fulfill our mission to provide safe and reliable water, life's most precious resource, and return clean water to our environment, all in an ethical, sustainable, and financially responsible manner.

The Annapolis Observer is **IRO's** weekly update on happenings in Annapolis and highlights the progress of key bills of interest to WSSC Water, as well as provide timely updates and calendar of important dates.

Legislative Updates

WSSC Water has proposed one bill for the 2023 Legislative Session - HB 783 (MC/PG 101-23) - Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission - Minority Business Enterprise Utilization Program - Revisions and Extension. This bill updates, modernizes, streamlines, and strengthens provisions pertaining to WSSC Water's Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) Utilization Program, including extending the Office of Supplier Diversity and Inclusion's statutory authority to have an MBE program for five (5) years, ending on June 30, 2028.

On March 10th, the Montgomery County House Delegation unanimously passed <u>HB 783</u> (MC/PG 101-23). The bill now awaits a recommendation from the House Health and Government Operations Committee who held their public bill hearing on March 6th.

The Prince George's County House Delegation voted unanimously to amend and pass <u>HB</u> 872 (MC/PG 111-23) on March 10th. As amended, this bill authorizes WSSC Water to enter into contracts with the District of Columbia or the District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a water supply, sewer, or drainage system for certain property located within a regional transit district in Prince George's County. This legislation was introduced at the request of the County Executive. The bill now moves to the Montgomery County House Delegation for consideration.

WSSC Water will continue to champion policies that provide safe and reliable water and

return clean water to our environment, all in an ethical, sustainable and financially responsible manner.

Estimated bills are given when WSSC Water is unable to capture an actual reading. The estimated bill is based on your historical usage during the same time last year. Customers who receive an estimated bill may be able submit an actual reading.
