CAUSE: GREASE AND WIPES EST OVERFLOW VOLUME: 320 GAL

UPON ARRIVAL, THE CREW FOUND MANHOLE 127U OVERFLOWING APPROXIMATELY 1 GPM, GOING INTO THE GRASSY AREA AROUND THE MANHOLE AND INTO A TRIBUTARY OF NORTHWEST BRANCH. THE CREW JETTED FROM MANHOLE 030U TO 127U A TOTAL OF 140FT, AND HIT AND RELIEVED GREASE AND WIPES AT 120FT, TO END THE EVENT.

STEPS TAKEN OR PLANNED TO REDUCE, ELIMINATE AND PREVENT RECURRENCE:

THE PROBLEM WITH THIS SEWER LINE HAS BEEN REFERRED TO LINE BLOCKAGE ANALYSIS (LBA) FOR REVIEW. A FOLLOW-UP INVESTIGATION WILL BE CONDUCTED TO DETERMINE WHAT MEASURES SHOULD BE TAKEN TO REDUCE OR ELIMINATE THE CHANCE OF THIS LINE OVERFLOWING AGAIN.

LIME VISIBLE SOLIDS REMOVED RAKED AREA

A WSSC CREW RAKED THE AREA AND SPREAD LIME IN THE GRASSY AREA AROUND THE MANHOLE.
