UPON ARRIVAL, THE CREW FOUND MANHOLE 075M OVERFLOWING 0.5GPM, ONTO THE GRASSY AREA AROUND THE MANHOLE. THE CREW JETTED FROM MANHOLE 111U TO 075M, A TOTAL OF 67', AND HIT AND RELIEVED HEAVY ROOTS AT 30', TO END THE EVENT.

STEPS TAKEN OR PLANNED TO REDUCE, ELIMINATE AND PREVENT RECURRENCE:
