- CAUSE: DEBRIS EST OVERFLOW VOLUME: 726 GAL UPON ARRIVAL, THE CREW FOUND MANHOLE 053U OVERFLOWING 5GPM, ENTERING A STORM DRAIN THAT OUTFALLS IN THE LITTLE FALLS BASIN. THE CREW JETTED FROM MANHOLE 130U TO 053U A TOTAL OF 77FT, AND HIT AND RELIEVED A SOFT DEBRIS BLOCKAGE AT 73FT', TO END THE EVENT.
- IMPACTS UPON PUBLIC HEALTH AND STATE WATERS: DRY WEATHER DISCOLORATION NOTICEABLE ODOR PUBLIC ACCESS

STEPS TAKEN OR PLANNED TO REDUCE, ELIMINATE AND PREVENT RECURRENCE: THE PROBLEM WITH THIS SEWER LINE HAS BEEN REFERRED TO LINE BLOCKAGE ANALYSIS (LBA) FOR REVIEW. A FOLLOW-UP INVESTIGATION WILL BE CONDUC-TED TO DETERMINE WHAT MEASURES SHOULD BE TAKEN TO REDUCE OR ELIMINATE THE CHANCE OF THIS LINE OVERFLOWING AGAIN.
