CAUSE: GREASE AND WIPES EST OVERFLOW VOLUME: 170 GAL  
UPON ARRIVAL, THE CREW FOUND MANHOLE 053U OVERFLOWING 2GPM, GOING ONTO THE PAVEMENT AND INTO A STORM DRAIN THAT OUTFALLS INTO THE LITTLE FALLS BASIN. THE CREW JETTED FROM MANHOLE 130U TO 053U, A TOTAL OF 77', AND HIT AND RELIEVED A GREASE AND WIPES BLOCKAGE AT 70', TO END THE EVENT.

STEPS TAKEN OR PLANNED TO REDUCE, ELIMINATE AND PREVENT RECURRENCE:  
THE PROBLEM WITH THIS SEWER LINE HAS BEEN REFERRED TO LINE BLOCKAGE ANALYSIS (LBA) FOR REVIEW. A FOLLOW-UP INVESTIGATION WILL BE CONDUCTED TO DETERMINE WHAT MEASURES SHOULD BE TAKEN TO REDUCE OR ELIMINATE THE CHANCE OF THIS LINE OVERFLOWING AGAIN.

MEASURES INITIATED/TAKEN TO MINIMIZE IMPACT:  
FLUSHED BACK INTO MANHOLE VISIBLE SOLIDS REMOVED

THE CREW WASHED DOWN THE AREA WITH DECHLORINATED WATER AND FLUSHED THE SOLIDS BACK INTO THE MANHOLE.
