CAUSE: GREASE AND WIPES EST OVERFLOW VOLUME: 414 GAL UPON ARRIVAL, THE CREW FOUND MANHOLE 036U OVERFLOWING 3GPM, ONTO THE PAVEMENT AND INTO A STORM DRAIN THAT OUTFALLS INTO THE NORTHEAST BRANCH BASIN. THE CREW JETTED FROM MANHOLE 035U TO 036U A TOTAL OF 183', AND HIT AND RELIEVED A GREASE, AND WIPES BLOCKAGE, AS WELL AS A BRICK IN THE CHANNEL OF MANHOLE 036U, TO END THE EVENT.

IMPACTS UPON PUBLIC HEALTH AND STATE WATERS: DRY WEATHER DISCOLORATION NOTICEABLE ODOR PUBLIC ACCESS PUBLIC USE OBSERVED

STEPS TAKEN OR PLANNED TO REDUCE, ELIMINATE AND PREVENT RECURRENCE: THE PROBLEM WITH THIS SEWER LINE HAS BEEN REFERRED TO LINE BLOCKAGE ANALYSIS (LBA) FOR REVIEW. A FOLLOW-UP INVESTIGATION WILL BE CONDUC-TED TO DETERMINE WHAT MEASURES SHOULD BE TAKEN TO REDUCE OR ELIMINATE THE CHANCE OF THIS LINE OVERFLOWING AGAIN.

MEASURES INITIATED/TAKEN TO MINIMIZE IMPACT: RAKED AREA VISIBLE SOLIDS REMOVED

THE CREW REMOVED VISIBLE SOLIDS, AND WASHED DOWN THE AREA WITH DECHLORINATED WATER.
