UPON ARRIVAL, THE CREW FOUND MANHOLE 062M OVERFLOWING AT 5GPM, ONTO THE GRASSY AREA AROUND THE MANHOLE, AND INTO A TRIBUTARY THAT OUTFALLS IN LOWER ANACOSTIA. THE CREW JETTED FROM MANHOLE 063U THROUGH MANHOLE 062M, AND HIT AND RELIEVED AN UNKNOWN BLOCKAGE AT

115', TO END THE EVENT.
