CAUSE: WIPES EST OVERFLOW VOLUME: 921 GAL
UPON ARRIVAL, THE CREW FOUND MANHOLE 303M OVERFLOWING AT 5GPM ONTO THE GRASSY AREA AROUND THE MANHOLE, AND INTO A NEARBY TRIBUTARY THAT OUTFALLS IN ROCK RUN. THE CREW JETTED FROM MANHOLE 154M TO 153U, A TOTAL OF 105', AND RELIEVED A WIPES BLOCKAGE AT 104', TO END THE EVENT.
