UPON ARRIVAL, THE CREW FOUND MANHOLE 278U OVERFLOWING ONTO THE
GRASSY AREA AROUND THE MANHOLE. THE CREW JETTED FROM
MANHOLE 276M, THROUGH 277M, TO 278U, A TOTAL OF 222', AND RELIEVED
A HEAVY GREASE AND ROOT BLOCKAGE AT 222', TO END THE EVENT.
