UPON ARRIVAL, THE CREW FOUND MANHOLE 047M OVERFLOWING AT 5GPM INTO JAMES CREEK. THE CREW JETTED FROM MANHOLE 046U TO 047M A TOTAL OF 391', AND HIT AND RELIEVED A ROOT BLOCKAGE AT 387', TO END THE EVENT.

STEPS TAKEN OR PLANNED TO REDUCE, ELIMINATE AND PREVENT RECURRENCE:
THE PROBLEM WITH THIS SEWER LINE HAS BEEN REFERRED TO LINE BLOCKAGE ANALYSIS (LBA) FOR REVIEW. A FOLLOW-UP INVESTIGATION WILL BE CONDUCTED TO DETERMINE WHAT MEASURES SHOULD BE TAKEN TO REDUCE OR ELIMINATE THE CHANCE OF THIS LINE OVERFLOWING AGAIN.
