Emergency

Financial Assistance Process

In Montgomery County, many public and community service agencies require applicants for financial assistance to have a written eviction, foreclosure, or utility disconnect notice as proof of the emergency. These public agencies have broad interpreter services available to communicate with residents during office hours in-person and electronically. An applicant also has the option to seek assistance directly (i.e., without a written referral) from other community-based organizations providing the desired type of assistance that serve the entire county or specific ZIP codes. These agencies are listed in the column headed as "Delinquency Notice Not Required."

Step 1:

Montgomery County residents seeking financial assistance should start the process by contacting the county's primary emergency assistance offices: Montgomery County Department of Health and Human Services (MCDHHS) or the Housing Opportunities Commission (if they are an HOC household, including Public Housing, Housing Choice Voucher, Tax Credit or State Rental Partnership). If the applicant does not approach HHS or HOC for some reason (e.g., they do not have a delinquency notice or HHS has helped them recently), the applicant can ask for a written referral to another agency and can then follow up with that organization.

Step 2:

An applicant also has the option to seek assistance directly (i.e., without a written referral) from other community-based organizations. These agencies are listed in the column headed as "Delinquency Notice Not Required." Applicants should contact the agencies providing the desired type of assistance in their location.
